Our Home-Based Services support families of preschool aged children (birth to school entry depending on the program area), who are experiencing, or at risk for, developmental delays.

Program Facilitators work one-on-one with families to provide services and support in the areas of **child development, family dynamics & community connections.**

REFERRALS & SERVICE AREA

Referrals for service can be made by families themselves or by others with the consent of the family. Our service area, depending on which program, ranges from an approximate 100 to 150 kilometre radius of the City of Lloydminster on both the Alberta and Saskatchewan sides, with some available regionally.
